Join us to celebrate the continued transformation of the East Columbia Drive waterfront at a ceremony to recognize the completion of Columbia Gardens Phase Two and introduce Gordon Estate Winery and Muret-Gaston Winery. The pandemic-postponed event will also celebrate the Food Truck Plaza's vendors: Culture Shock Bistro, Only Tacos, Ann's Best Creole & Soul Food, Taste of Wok, Bobablastic Tri-Cities, Swampy's BBQ and Rollin' Ice Cream.

Phase Two involved constructing additional parking, a loop roadway, utilities, landscaping, new artwork, signage and a signalized pedestrian crossing. A Food Truck Plaza was established, and six shovel-ready parcels were readied for sale to encourage private-sector investment in the historic waterfront district. Columbia Gardens is unique because it is zoned as "Urban Mixed-Use" and federally designated as an "Opportunity Zone."
