6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

a. Commissioner Update on Mural Art Research

Commission Chair McKenzie Kennedy gave an update on the research she conducted on Underpass Murals. She discovered that a project that was recently done on the west side, in partnership with DOT, was completed for around \$6,000 - \$12,000. She is working on a spreadsheet with more information that she will be

sending to the commission and staff.

Staff had also discussed some potential partnership opportunities with Kennewick School District or other businesses.

7. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Review Port of Kennewick proposal for traffic utility box art.

The Commission was presented with a design from the Port of Kennewick with an aging traffic box wrap that needs replacing off of Washington and Columbia Drive. HDKP and STCU were consulted on the rewapping of this utility box and gave their approval for Port of Kennewick to fund this traffic box wrap.

Richard Reuther moved to approve the preliminary design with a final mock-up of the Utility Box to be reviewed by the Commission for approval. Commission Chair Kennedy seconded. All were in favor.

8. BUDGET UPDATE

\$9,095 is the current budget for the Arts Commission.

Staff recently purchased tickets for the Downtown Impact Awards on September 18th. The City will have two tables at this event, and we encourage all commissioners to attend as we will be presenting our Energize the Arts awards which were also recently purchased.

9. COMMENTS

1. Staff let the commissioners know about an piece of roundabout art (Triumph over Harmony) that has been damaged and needs repair. Our Risk and Safety Department will be covering the costs of these repairs which are being completed by Mustang Signs. The artist has approved Mustang to work on this sculpture as they have the necessary tools and equipment.

2. Staff submitted a new program request this budget cycle for new signage at the Civic Center (Keewaydin parks, library, city hall, community center, KPD, etc.) which totaled to \$18,000. Another request was put in to add signage along HWY 395 and place the horse sculptures at the base of the sign located at our Southridge location.

3. There was some discussion on starting to consider where the metal fish can be placed as public art. These were previously installed in the center median of Canal Dr.

4. Staff will be releasing a Call for Artists at the end of August for new traffic box wraps

for review by the commission in October.

5. The City Clerk's Office will be working on filling vacancies for boards and commissions prior to the next round of applicants in March.
